

OFFICE ERGONOMICS

<u>Description:</u>



The course will reflect current literature, best practices in industry and the current revisions highlighted in the updated CSA standard on office ergonomic guidelines that was just recently released.

Learning Objectives:

- Develop an understanding of musculoskeletal injury (MSI) risks and strategies to minimize risk
- Learn how to identify ergonomic concerns and apply strategies to minimize work station set up concerns
- Understand the basic principles of ergonomic equipment selection
- Develop an understanding of new issues that are arising in office ergonomics including: sit/stand work stations, computer vision syndrome and the impact of LED lighting.
